Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waiver providers are now required to enroll in the MassHealth program with an assigned MassHealth Waiver Provider number. If you provide services to individuals who are enrolled in the Frail Elder HCBS Waiver, you must complete the posted MassHealth enrollment forms: Frail Elder Home and Community Based Services Waiver Provider Application; Massachusetts Medicaid Program Provider Agreement and Acknowledgement of Terms of Participation for Frail Elder Waiver Home and Community Based Services Waiver Providers; Federally Required Disclosures; and Data Collection Form and Registration Instructions.

This will not change the relationship with the Aging Services Access Point (ASAP). Contracts are executed with the ASAP and providers bill the ASAP directly. The ASAP will continue to authorize and make payments for services provided to the Frail Elder Waiver participant.

Providers may already have a MassHealth Provider number that allows you to provide services for a MassHealth program. You still need to complete these posted MassHealth enrollment forms because you will need a separate MassHealth Waiver Provider number in order to provide Frail Elder HCBS waiver services. If needed, the form to List MassHealth Provider Identification Numbers is posted.

To assist you with the completion of the MassHealth enrollment forms, the *Frail Elder Waiver Provider Application Helpful Tips for Completing the MassHealth Required Forms* is also posted.

ASAP providers and interested ASAP providers should download and review these documents. The ASAP will provide specific instructions.
