RE: Revised Cost Share Table for the Home Care Program 2021

# **Purpose:**

This Program Instruction (PI) transmits the Financial Eligibility Guidelines that take effect on May 1, 2021 for the Home Care Program, and sets out the voluntary co-payment, cost sharing, and over-income co-payment schedules.

#### **Background:**

The U.S. Social Security Administration recently announced a 1.3 percent Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) increase from calendar year 2020. Accordingly, monthly Social Security and SSI benefits will increase 1.3 percent in calendar year 2021.

As required under 651 CMR 3.04(4)(b), the Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) has adjusted the Financial Eligibility Guidelines to incorporate the COLA increase. By increasing these Financial Eligibility Guidelines, EOEA ensures anyone at or below Federal Poverty Level (FPL) will be excluded from cost sharing for services.

# Revised Voluntary Co-payment and Cost Share Schedule:

EOEA will continue to request a voluntary donation from consumers whose income does not exceed the amounts set forth in the Voluntary Copayment section of the Financial Eligibility Guidelines. MassHealth members with any coverage type whose income is at or below 300% of Supplemental Security Income Federal Benefit Rate (SSI FBR) are exempt from all copayments, including voluntary co-payments. Aging Services Access Points (ASAPS) will continue to have the ability to waive and reduce fees based on hardships that impact the consumer's ability to pay.

#### **Effective Date:**

The effective date of this Program Instruction is May 1, 2021.
