


### Serving Older Adults with Limited English Proficiency Tuesday, July 30<sup>th</sup> from 11:00am-12:00pm

## **HHPP Learning Collaborative Survey Results**





# Program Overview: Somerville-Cambridge Elder Services (SCES) and Cambridge Health Alliance (CHA)

# History

- Began discussions in 2011 between:
  - Cambridge Health Alliance
  - Hallmark Health
  - Mystic Valley Elder Services
  - Somerville Cambridge Elder Services
- Granted Community Care Transitions Program (CCTP) funding in 2012
- Funding ended in 2016 (as planned)
- CHA continued to fund care transitions programs with SCES staff from 2016 – present
  - Part of ACO's Complex Care Management Team
- Received ARPA funding through EOHHS for current H2H Hospital Liaison intervention

# Program Description

- Liaisons are embedded in the 2 hospitals
- On-site 3-4 days per week
  - Sit with the care teams for documentation
  - Attend rounds
  - Meet with patients
  - Consult with staff on potential referrals
- Conduct home visits within 3 days, sooner in higher risk cases
- Follow up with medical providers
- Follow up calls/home visits with patients
- Document hospital visit, home visit and closure in Epic, along with additional information relevant to care team

## Successes

- Inpatient teams and Liaisons sit in the same space which has led to natural consultations and learning on both sides. Extends beyond Case Managers and includes PT, and ED staff
- Liaisons are able to alert consumers already enrolled in ASAP programs of hospitalizations so d/c planning can start earlier
- Liaisons are reporting back to inpatient teams and outpatient clinics issues in the community
  - Participation in daily safety meetings to drive change

## Areas for Exploration

- Every ASAP has small differences and Liaisons cannot always speak to what will happen when d/c'd to another catchment area
- Role of Liaison is not always clear across disciplines
  - Hierarchy within the hospital and can be hard to navigate as a new Liaison coming in to an established system
- Discharge planning is complex and where patient will discharge to can change last minute either due to space, payment or patient choice
- On the fence STR vs home cases rehab often needed due to ASAP services not being able to start same day
